



TRANSEUROPE MARINAS

JOINING RULES AND PRINCIPLES

TransEurope Marinas is a registered association of select marinas, currently located along or within sailing reach of the coastlines of England, Scotland, Wales, Ireland, Germany, the Netherlands, Belgium, France, Spain, Italy, Greece, Croatia, and Montenegro.

TransEurope Marinas members must offer a high level of services in their marinas, having a good reputation for their facilities, quality of service and visitors' welcome. Each marina must be at least one day's sailing from each other, to avoid competition in the same area.

TransEurope Marinas members agree to offer reciprocal arrangements for their berth holders visiting another marina; currently 50% discount on visitor rates and limited to a total of 5 days' use per year comprising one or more visits in each of the member marinas. Additional privileges and discounts could be given locally by certain marinas as suits them, but they are not part of our general agreement.

Membership cards are only available for long-term (min. 6-months occupancy) berth-holders within member marinas. Digital membership cards are provided at the start of the year by home marinas, and the membership code should be quoted when visiting associated marinas, to be able to claim the 50% berthing discount.

The TransEurope Marinas managers undertake to maintain a close and friendly relationship between them; to exchange practical and technical insights and to promote the other marinas should the opportunity arise. TransEurope Marinas members meet four times a year and promote TransEurope within individual marinas or on stands at boat shows; forwarding information about the TransEurope member marinas to berth holders and visitors.

On the occasion of these meetings, members decide the common policy of the group. Decisions are customarily approved with unanimous support of the members present at the meeting. Each marina pays an annual contribution to TransEurope Marinas to cover the costs of our common actions (membership cards, brochures, website, flags, etc). For 2026 the contribution is £340 or 390€ and remains deliberately limited to the lowest necessary amount. The additional registration fee for new members is £100 or 120€) and applied solely for the first year of membership, to cover administrative and website update costs.

Marinas wishing to join the TransEurope Marinas group are requested to send a written application with all the marina's details and contacts to our Chair. Where there is an existing TransEurope Marinas member within 30 nautical miles of the marina wishing to join, the applicant must first obtain that member's consent to the application and include the written consent with its application. After a discussion and possibly a visit to the marina, the application will be considered by the membership at the following TransEurope Marinas meeting.
